Radiocarbon Dates for the Wairarapa - III

The following series of radiocarbon dates have been recently received from the Institute of Nuclear Sciences, Lower Hutt. They derive from excavations conducted in the Palliser Bay area over the last two and a half years and complement others listed in the Newsletter in 1971. The analysis of excavated material is well underway in Dunedin and full reports of all excavations and other work will be published towards the end of 1972.
