## RECENT REPORTS

Reports recently received by Central File:

Jacomb, C. 1997. Archaeological sites at Pegasus Bay Coastal Estates, Woodend, North Canterbury. Unpublished report to Boffa Miskell. 9 pp. [An archaeological assessment of an area of forest and grazing land in which 42 sites have been recorded, 17 as a result of the 1997 survey.]

Jacomb, C. 1999. An archaeological survey of the site of the first Pukaki Inn (H38/9), Mackenzie Basin, Canterbury, New Zealand. Unpublished report. 14 pp. [A detailed survey of the site of an inn, probably built in 1876.]

Petchey, P. 1999. Cardrona Valley archaeological survey. Report for Southroads Ltd. 81 pp. [Survey of the floor of the valley south of Cardrona preparatory to the upgrading of the Crown Range Road. The upper valley contains numerous well-preserved sites, including dwelling sites, workings, tailings and water races. The technology is typical of early goldfields sites. A small excavation in Cardrona township is also briefly reported.]

Trotter, M., B. McCulloch 1999. Impact of a planting programme on historic and archaeological sites of Quail Island, Lyttelton Harbour. Conservation Advisory Science Notes 264, Department of Conservation, Wellington. 21 pp. [A brief review of the history of the island, a discussion of the planting proposals, and an assessment of the likely impact of planting on known sites, with recommendations.]
