Hamel, J. 2001. *The Archaeology of Otago*. Department of Conservation, Wellington. 226 pp.

O'Keeffe, M. 2001. Proposed redevelopment of Fort Dorset, Seatoun, Archaeological Assessment. Unpublished report. 25 pp plus copies of SRFs. [Assessment of the likely impact of proposed development on archaeological sites at Fort Dorset, the former military base at Seatoun Wellington.]

O'Keeffe, M. 2001. Archaeological Monitoring: Flat Point subdivision, Wairarapa. Unpublished report. 6 pp. [Trenches for services in a lifestyle subdivision monitored. One midden located and recorded.]

Petchey, P. 2001. ASB Site, 24 Camp St., Queenstown. Report on archaeological investigations, 2001. Unpublished report. 33 pp. [Investigation yielded a mix of features and artefacts of various dates reflecting several redevelopments of the site since 1860s. Unusual artefacts included opium tins, glassware, and perfume bottles.]

Sewell, B. 2001. State Highway 1. Mercer to Long Swamp realignment. Archaeological Investigations. Unpublished report. 20 pp. [Investigations undertaken at three sites during the realignment of State Highway 1 near Mercer. S12/289 revealed a midden and a number of fire scoops and S12/290 a pit with a central posthole alignment.]

Slocombe, A. 2001. An archaeological Investigation of wetland site P06/82, Kaikohe. Department of Conservation, Northland Conservancy Historical Series 4. [Report on salvage excavation undertaken in 1995 including discussion of the mostly wooden artefacts recovered.]
