Unpublished collaborative report, University of Auckland. 22 pp. (Outlines results of archaeological excavations at P19/261 and P19/262 carried out in January and February to March 2002 in response to the new proposed Bell Block bypass, New Plymouth. Geophysical survey techniques were used to define areas. Excavations at P19/262 revealed a large historic house constructed in traditional style and the remains of two earlier structures, probably both large houses.
